



INDIANA AFL-CIO 2022 LEGISLATIVE SCORECARD



SB78; RC229 **PENSION & DISABILITY FUND**

Provides that after July 1, 2022, if the board of trustees of the Indiana public retirement system determines that a new police officer or firefighter in (PERF) should be a member of the 1977 fund. This Bill will secure better benefits and protections for public safety.

STATUS: BECAME LAW



SB265; RC219 **CARBON SEQUESTRATION**

Changes the description of the carbon sequestration pilot project that is authorized under current law. Eliminates the requirement that the operator of the carbon sequestration pilot project be designated by the director of the department of natural resources. This bill will create hundreds of jobs for the Terre Haute area.

STATUS: DEAD BILL



HB1221; RC59 **ELECTRIC VEHICLES & ELECTRICITY PRICING**

Provides that a person that: (1) owns, operates, or leases electric vehicle (EV) supply equipment; and (2) makes the EV supply equipment available for use by the public for compensation; This Bill will create thousands of jobs for our members

STATUS: BECAME LAW



HB1251; RC159 **ADJUNCT TEACHER BILL**

This bill will allow school systems to hire adjunct teachers that are not under the collective bargaining agreement and to compensate them whatever they wish

STATUS: BECAME LAW



SB179; RC156 **AUTOMATED TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM**

Provides that the Indiana department of transportation (department) may establish the automated traffic control system pilot program (program) for the purpose of enforcing work zone speed limits. This program has the potential to reduce deaths and injuries for highway workers

STATUS: DEAD BILL



HB1269; RC102 **ANTI-PLA LEGISLATION**

This bill is the watered-down anti PLA-RBO bill that weakens apprenticeship standards on design build projects and would have a negative effect on our building trades members.

STATUS: DEAD BILL



HB1153; RCT15 **WORKERS COMP INCREASE**

Increases benefits for injuries and disablements for workers by 3% each year for four years which will be a total increase of 12%. This is Indiana's first workers comp increase since 2016.

STATUS: BECAME LAW



SB76; RC7 **MEET & CONFER PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES**

Allows an employer or an exclusive recognized representative of full-time employees of a police or fire department to request, in specified circumstances, an advisory opinion from the commissioner of labor. This bill requires cities and towns to discuss Non-Binding mediation with issues that affect our members

STATUS: BECAME LAW



SB297; RC261 **DUES DEDUCTIONS**

Amends the content of the statement that is required to be included on an authorization form for deducting school employee organization dues from school employee pay. This bill will affect the way union deductions are taken out of your paycheck which makes it more inconvenient for our members.

STATUS: BECAME LAW



HB1134; RCT14 **CLASSROOM CENSORSHIP**

This bill would allow parents the option to unenroll their children from classes and takes away the teacher's ability to voice their opinions on topics like Nazism, Marxism (and all other ___isms).
